ECPR Anniversary Volume: *European Political Science at 50*

**European University Institute
Badia Fiesolana, 3-4 June 2019**

In 2020, the European Consortium for Political Research (ECPR) will celebrate its 50th anniversary. On this occasion, it sponsors the publication of a collective volume that reflects on the origins and development of European political science. The book provides a critical assessment of the achievements of the discipline and the challenges it faces.

The volume, coedited by Thibaud Boncourt (University Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne), Isabelle Engeli (University of Exeter) and Diego Garzia (University of Lucerne), is structured around 14 chapters. Chapters 2 to 6 review what European political science means in terms of objects, paradigms, data, and methods to discuss the existence of a “European touch” in political science. Chapters 7 to 10 move the focus to the producers of European political science to discuss the state of the profession. Chapters 11 to 14 discuss what European political science is for and how it responds to the external environment.

The workshop is kindly hosted by the Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies. It will be the occasion to discuss the draft chapters in the presence of their authors. The EUI community is very welcome to attend and participate!
